## Algebra P3-P4

In this course we will cover the second half of Algebra 1. This is among the first stepping stones for every other math course this school offers. Mastering the content in this class will be critical to your success in future classes.

### Materials:

- Three ring binder four sections: warm-ups, notes, homework, and tests. You are encouraged to keep your notes from last semester to use as a future resource.
- Notebook paper.
- Writing utensil – pen or pencil is fine, as long as your work is easily legible.
- Calculators will be provided for you when necessary

### Grades:

- Your grade will be calculated with the following weighted average:
  - 65% - Tests
  - 15% - Assignments
  - 20% - Final Exam
- Tests will be given every other Friday. Anything we have covered is fair game, not just the material from the previous two weeks. You may take make-up tests during SMART period, or you may schedule a time with me after school.
- Homework will be graded on a 5 point scale, purely on completion and effort. Late work will be given a maximum of 4 points. No credit will be given for assignments that are more than two weeks late.

### Expectations:

- No cell phones. They will be taken. You can pick them up two minutes after the bell.
- The first five minutes of every class is devoted to a warm-up. You are expected to work silently during this time.
- No open-container drinks. Do not eat.
