



## Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Honors Math Testing in the Tamalpais District

**What if my student has an extended time accommodation?**

Students that have documented accommodations will be provided extra time according to their documented needs. Please bring the documentation with you.

**What if I can't make it to the testing date?**

Please make arrangements to attend any one of the 3 testing dates and locations. You are not limited to the site you plan to attend next year. These are the only available dates available for testing. There will be no make-up dates.

**What should I study for the test?**

There are no study materials for the test. Learning the content in your current course will help you on the exam. We don't just look for your skill on the test, we are also looking at how you think about mathematics and progress through difficult, non-routine problems.

**When will I know the results?**

It takes 2-3 weeks to get the tests scored and processed at which point you will receive a letter in the mail indicating your results and what your next steps will be.

**What if I don't pass the test?**

You will receive a letter in the mail outlining next steps if you are interested in appealing the results of your test. If you are still not granted admission to the honors course, please know our regular courses provide a great deal of rigor and prepare you for the next level regular or honors course.
