

Student Success Team

Referring a student to an SST:

Prior to referring, complete the following:

- A parent/teacher/student meeting
- Various tier one and tier two interventions have been implemented with little growth
- Meeting with the counselor to discuss possible issues outside of classroom environment or systemic across many classes

To refer a student to an SST:

- Work with counselor or Assist. Principal to begin process. InT begins monitoring
- SST scheduled with teachers, student, parent, counselor and AP- team lead determined

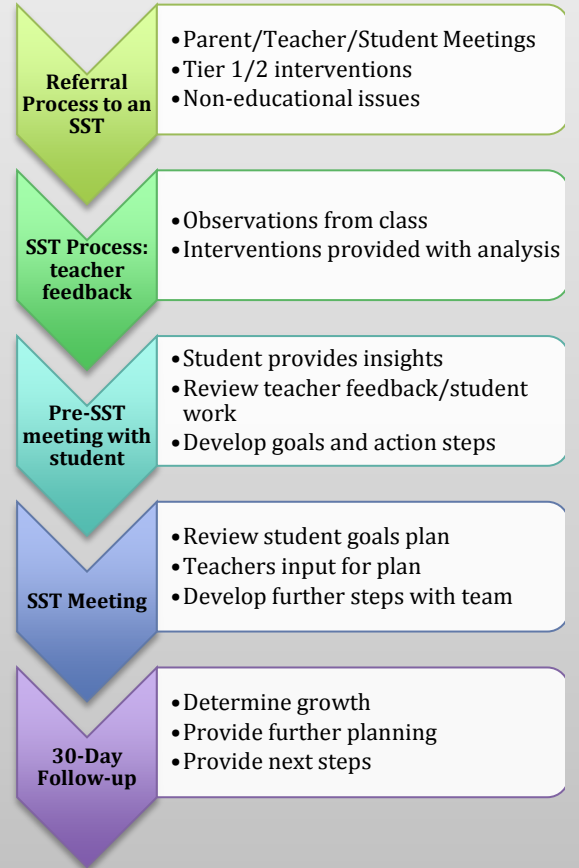
SST Process: Teacher Feedback:

- Each teacher completes the teacher feedback form and returns to InT
- Piece(s) of student work to demonstrate success or challenges with interventions
- Information will be shared with student

Pre-SST Meeting with Student:

- SST Lead begins developing plan with student around strengths and areas of concerns
- Reviews teacher feedback and student work to further develop plan
- Develops goal(s) and action steps
- Send SST plan to teachers/parents

The SST Process



Student Success Team Meeting:

- Review student's goals and action steps the student and SST lead developed
- Teachers provide input to the plan based on their observations and interventions they have tried
- Develop further action steps with team input that student can achieve in 30 days
- Provide copies of agreed plan to team members and InT for monitoring over next 30 days
- Counselor team member in InT, reports to InT about success and concerns and sets follow-up

30-Day Follow-up:

- Determine through student work/actions if growth has been made in 30 days
- Provide further development to plan if necessary
- Provide next steps for continuation of plan or new accommodations
- If determined that student is still struggling, student referred to Intervention Team monitoring
