RESOLUTION NO. 18-24**

Resolution Regarding Non-Reemployment of Certificated Employees

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2019, the Governing Board of the Tamalpais Union High School District adopted Resolution No. 18-18 to decrease certificated staff due to a reduction or elimination in particular kinds of services; and

WHEREAS, notice of non-reemployment was given to the affected employees on or before March 15, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the affected employees waived their right to a hearing; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that 2.2 full-time equivalent services of the District be reduced and an equivalent number of certificated staff be non-reemployed for the ensuing 2019-2020 school year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the employees listed below shall be non-reemployed, or their work year/work day reduced, effective for the 2019-2020 school year. This action shall be effective on June 30, 2019:


