RESOLUTION # 21-7

RESOLUTION TO ELIMINATE AND/OR REDUCE THE NUMBER OF CERTIFICATED EMPLOYEES DUE TO A REDUCTION IN PARTICULAR KINDS OF SERVICES

WHEREAS, Education Code section 44955 permits the Governing Board to reduce or discontinue particular kinds of services not later than the beginning of the next school year; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Tamalpais Union High School District has determined that it shall be necessary to decrease the following programs and services of the District no later than the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year; and

WHEREAS, it shall be necessary to terminate at the end of the 2021-2022 school year the employment of certain certificated employees of the District as a result of the elimination of the programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Tamalpais Union High School District has further determined that among employees who first rendered paid service to the District on the same day, the order of termination will be based solely on the needs of the District and students thereof;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Tamalpais Union High School District that the following particular kinds of services shall be reduced or eliminated no later than the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year:

Art Teacher:	Redwood High School	0.6 FTE
Art Teacher:	Redwood High School	0.4 FTE
Math Teacher:	Redwood High School	0.8 FTE

Soc. Sci. Teacher:	Archie Williams High School	1.0 FTE
Soc. Sci. Teacher:	Redwood High School	0.8 FTE

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or his/her designee is directed to send appropriate notices to all employees whose positions may be lost by virtue of this action. Nothing herein shall be deemed to confer any status or rights upon temporary certificated employees or other employee in addition to those specifically granted to such employees by statute.


