❖ **Register to Vote**

Giants, the 2020 Election is less than 50 days away! Have you registered to vote yet if you're 18, or pre-registered if you're 16 or 17? If not, please register or pre-register today in SMART! Your teacher or Leadership representative will supply all the necessary information. Registering takes less than 5 minutes so you still have plenty of time to do homework. It is strongly advised that you bring your California driver license number, California ID number, or the last four numbers of your Social Security number. Voting is the most important right and duty that US citizens have and it is super important that you register so that you can vote! HOW TO REGISTER PEOPLE: (\*please estimate how many students get registered in your SMART by the end)

1. **\*\*\*Show all 16, 17, and 18 year olds in your class this link: [registertovote.ca.gov](https://registertovote.ca.gov)**
2. Fill out all necessary info (it has an red asterisks next to it); includes name, address, date/place of birth, political party affiliation
  - a. Name must be their given name; the one on their Social Security, Driver License, etc.
  - b. NOTE: This is **NON-PARTISAN (meaning you CANNOT support Democrats or Republicans)**. The major parties in California are the Democratic and the Republican Party. Info about other parties is at this link: <https://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/political-parties/party-statements/>. If students have no affiliation, check the box saying "No Party/None."
  - c. ALSO, students **DO NOT need to provide** their CA driver license number, CA ID number, or Social Security number but it is highly suggested. If they do not, however, they may have to show it when voting for the first time.
3. On Page 3, there are a few questions about whether you want a mail-in ballot and/or info packets about candidates sent to you every election. This is entirely up to you, and you can always change your selection later.
4. REMEMBER: It is super important that **all information is filled out correctly**--it is a federal crime to lie on the registration.
5. Sign up for Where's My Ballot? to track your ballot after sending it in: <https://california.ballottrax.net/voter/>. Only need name, birth date, and zip code.
6. **VOTE EARLY!**
