Drive In Graduation at Marin Civic Center

We are so excited to have our drive-in graduation ceremony at the **Marin Civic Center's** Lagoon Park on **Friday, June 12**. Using a large screen and FM and Web-based **livestream**, this **drive-in ceremony** will allow us to have **student speeches, music performances**, student names read aloud and the traditional **turn of the tassel**.

Each graduate *received* their **ticket for admission** to the graduation ceremony in their pick-up bag on Monday, June 8. This ticket **must be displayed** prominently on the front dash of your vehicle.

The ceremony will be audible via FM radio in your car and available via live webstreaming on your internet device.

Each graduate is permitted only one car (max 7 seats, no RVs) to attend with their family (families with twins also only get one car).

The windows may be rolled down, the sun roof can be open, convertible cars can have the top down, but all family members must remain in the car with a mask on.

The graduating senior is the **ONLY** family member allowed out of the car. They may sit or stand in front of the car, on the car, in the back/trunk or bed of a truck, or through a sunroof. No other family members can be out of the car, including windows and sunroofs at any point during the ceremony. Students must wear a mask whenever they are outside the car.

No student can leave the perimeter of their car at any time.

There are **no restroom facilities** available so plan accordingly (go before you go).
