

Drake HS Parking Permit Application 2019-2020

Please read below information thoroughly before filling out the application.

Permit applications are due in the School Main Office by **Monday, June 3rd at 4:00pm.**

You must also turn in a copy of your current, valid driver's license in order to be considered*. Available permits will be awarded at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year. No permits will be issued to students without a license by Aug. 20. Students will be notified just prior to the start of school.

Any applications turned in to the office after the deadline will be put on a waiting list. Students on the waiting list will be awarded permits **if** they become available.

Permit Selection Process:

- Priority primarily based on distance from school.
- Priority given to carpools (3 students or more). Failure to regularly meet carpool responsibility may result in loss of privileges. Carpool drivers will specify the names of students occupying their carpool.
- We will also give consideration to students who have special circumstances with regard to their transportation needs (ie. work, caretaker responsibilities, dual school enrollment). These will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- Distance and carpools combined will receive the highest priority

Parking Violations:

- Students must park in their designated spot, and may NOT park in any other spot, including fire lanes and visitor parking or you will be ticketed. See Mark Machado if there are any issues or questions about your reserved spot during the school year.
- Attendance will be a key factor in maintaining a parking permit. Having a parking permit should mean no tardies. For excessive tardiness and absences (excused and unexcused) student permits will be revoked. Parking is for students who consistently attend school.
- Violating these rules may result in the following consequences: a warning, permit revoked for one week, permit revoked for a month, and permit revoked for rest of school year.

Improperly parked vehicles may be cited and/or towed by Central Marin Police Department.

Your permit is your responsibility! If it is lost, stolen, falls off, etc., you will be charged \$5.00 to replace it.
