STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS 2019-2020

All four programs are open to all students who are interested in pursuing leadership opportunities at Drake. ASB, Peer Resource and SOAR are classes students will take for the year. Crew Leaders is an outside program where students lead our Crews but do not attend a class. Applications are available in the AP Office.

ASB Leadership:

Drake's Associated Student Body Leadership program is Drake's student government. This student-led organization strives toward building leadership skills, school unity and increased student involvement in the school and community and is committed to the following Core Values including: Capturing and creating a sound voice for students to make/effect change, motivating others to become involved, building a bridge from Drake to the larger community, seeking community service opportunities as a class and as a school and working to improve equity at Drake. There are two ways to get involved in the ASB program. First, students can run for an elected office OR apply to become a member of the class. Applications for both are available on January 31 in the AP Office. Officer applications are due on February 13th and Class applications are due March 15th. Questions? Peer Resource:

The Drake Peer Resource program is designed for students to foster community and promote student health and wellness on campus through education, awareness and prevention strategies. The program promotes students to become skilled and effective peer supporters. Peer Resource students receive comprehensive education on various health and wellness topics and educate the larger school community. This leadership program is open to all interested 10-12 grade students. Applications must be completed and returned to the AP Office by February 28, 2019. SOAR: Students Organized for Anti-Racism

This is a new leadership program at Drake where students become courageous racial equity leaders. Our mission is to raise awareness and educate our Drake community about racism, both unconscious and conscious, in order to provide a safe place for all Drake students and staff. Students will then investigate how race shows up at Drake and will create action projects to address racial inequities in our school, in our district, and in our community. Students will learn how they can interrupt racism in their own lives. Students create and lead efforts to address these issues, as well as those that challenge systemic racism.
