### **Applications due to AP Office at 8:00 a.m. Friday February 17, 2017**

Applicants for ASB or Class officers **must** meet the following eligibility requirements:

- GPA of 2.0 or higher on most grade report. (First Semester 2016-17)
- In addition to meeting academic requirements of a 2.0, officer applicants must have and maintain a record of good attendance and citizenship. If, for some reason, it is decided that you are not eligible to run, you will be notified.

Applicants for ASB officer for 2017-2018 **must** meet the following commitments or risk being removed from the election process:

Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup>

- Attend the mandatory Candidates Meeting at lunch in the PE classroom.

Friday, February 17<sup>th</sup>

- Turn in your attached application signed by you and your parent/guardian, Must also have 25 student signatures and 5 teacher signatures to the AP Office.

Monday, February 27

- Email your one minute speech to Ms. Peterson ([dpeterson@tamdistrict.org](mailto:dpeterson@tamdistrict.org)) by 8:00am am for approval to deliver on PTV. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the election process.
- You will be on Pirate TV with your speech. We will be filing you Monday or Tuesday. More information to come. You **MUST** deliver the speech provided on Monday morning and have it approved.

Monday February 27- Friday March 3<sup>rd</sup>

- Campaign according to the Campaigning Guidelines.
- Campaign faire at break on Wednesday March 1 under the senior tree.

  - Max 50 flyers (don't waste paper though)
  - First come first serve for placement of posters. Campaigning begins at break on Monday February 27 at 9:41. No campaign materials can be seen on campus until this time.
  - All campaign materials must be approved by Ms. Peterson and **MUST** be stamped by Tanya Jaspering for approval
4. **No** negative ads against other candidates
