The California Education Code and the Rules & Regulations of the State Board of Education require instruction in certain specific fields in all California public schools.

District Graduation Requirements

According to Board Policy 6146.1(a), students shall receive diplomas of graduation from high school only after completing the required course of study and meeting the standards of proficiency established by the District. To qualify for graduation and to participate in the ceremonies, a student must successfully meet the requirements outlined below:
