**Over \$2,200** in prizes will be awarded prizes to the winners and for their school or organization, in two age categories, 12-14 and 15-18. Following the contest, the finalist and winning posters will be taken on a Bay Area exhibition tour, including a special presentation at the 2019 Marin County Fair.
