1. At the bottom of the client, click the up arrow next to Stop Video.
2. Select Change Virtual Background.
3. In the Virtual Background tab, upload your own image.
4. To add your own image or video, click the + icon to upload from your computer.

How to change your Zoom background on the mobile app

1. Tap the three dots at the bottom right to open the More menu.
