The symbol *ff fortissimo*—means: very loud
The symbol *pp pianissimo*—means: very soft

D.S. = Dal Segno—means: go back to the sign (♯) *Fine* = the end
If we put them together, we get:
D.S. al Fine = Go back to the sign (♯) and play to the end, indicated by *Fine*.

Moderato ♩ = 116
