<u>Final Exams at Tamiscal for Independent Study Only</u> December 6th-10th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All work is due by Friday, December 3rd, unless it relates to a final or culminating project ● Final's week is the week of December 6th-10th. We will use our existing class schedule for tests and cumulative projects. ● Core <i>may</i> have scheduled times for group projects/tests, and if so, they will communicate that directly with students - most likely during advisory time on 12/10. ● *CEC and Pathways students in IS group classes will take finals during this week as well. <p><i>*IS finals occur a week earlier than other schools/programs to avoid conflicts with finals for students co-enrolled in their home school, and provide time for IS teachers to complete mandatory compliance paperwork for independent study.</i></p>
<u>Mandatory Interventions</u> Case-by-case basis December 13th-17th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If a student is behind (facing credit loss or a failing grade) they will be required to complete work during the week of December 13th-17th ● Some students may be asked to participate in additional SIS time this week, or meet individually with your teacher(s) ● Mandatory interventions may occur remotely or in-person (as determined by the teacher) ● Teachers will reach out directly to these students with instructions
<u>Co-enrollments at Big Schools, Pathways and CEC</u> Final Exams the week of December 13th-17th	<p>Students co-enrolled in another TUHSD school will take finals according to that school's final exam schedule - please check those websites.</p> <p>Students in the Pathways and CEC program attend classes through December 17th.</p> <p>College of Marin finals will take place this week, too.</p>

Check with your professor for a specific day and time.● Students co-enrolled in a Tamiscal math or science class will take those finals the week of December 6th-10th according to the regular schedule● Students co-enrolled at another district school will take those finals the week of Dec 13th-17th according to their final exam schedule (check websites).

Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students will attend school according to the typical schedule the week of December 6th-10th● All Edgenuity course work should be completed by December 17th, including all final test and projects in Edgenuity● Students who are on track in their classes will have early release days the week of December 13-17th from 9-12● Students needing more time to finish their coursework should attend until 3 pm M-Th and 2 pm Friday according to the regular schedule
