## Social Issues:

We believe that the government has absolutely no role in the affairs of the individual. This means that if we were in power, the government have zero say in personal matters such as abortion, immigration, and marriage laws. Specifically, we will eliminate all government regulations on institutions such as marriage. We are also one hundred percent committed to the freedoms expressed in the bill of rights; especially freedom of speech, which shall not be abridged under any circumstances, and the right to bear arms, which shall likewise never be taken away. We will eliminate all regulations the government has on firearms. Finally, the issue of privacy is one of the biggest examples of government tyranny, and under our administration organizations such as the NSA and FBI would be forced to comply to strict oversight laws by the citizens of the United States, or be abolished. These policies are tailored to fit well among moderate liberal voters in states such as Colorado, New Mexico, Michigan, and Ohio. Our balance with liberal ideas of self-ownership and conservative values of property ownership should allow us to gain many voters in Swing states.

## Environment:

We believe that the free market is the best way to protect the environment, as consumers will make conscientious choices to only buy from companies that serve the environment well, and landowners and other owners of natural resources will work to preserve them. We will eliminate National Parks, and other protected areas. We firmly assert that in all cases, the economy should be a free market, and this includes the energy industry; there should be no regulations on these corporations. The government is incompetent and will do more harm to the environment than good, and their regulations will also inhibit the ability of businesses to exert their natural rights. This deregulation will probably be popular among few states, but our policy on energy will be popular among states with heavy fossil fuel industries, such as West Virginia and North Dakota, and likely among older, white Americans who will die before climate change matters.

## Economy:

We believe that the free market is most important, and that there should be no restrictions on people's property rights and commerce. The government should play no role in regulating the economy, as these regulations go against the laws of the invisible hand and do more harm than good. This applies to many current markets that we will open, such as prostitution, education, and drugs. Additionally, we believe that the heavy taxation of the American people is theft, and that all of the government's money should come from voluntary donations. Therefore we shall abolish the IRS, and eliminate the existence of government tax collectors. These ideas have already been accepted by a majority of the nation, and conservative states such as Texas, Alabama, and Mississippi should support these policies, as rural voters, which is a demographic we're targeting.

## Foreign Policy:

While we support the creation and maintenance of a national military, we believe it should be used exclusively for defense of our own citizen's liberties, and we should seek peace with all foreign countries. We despise any kind of foreign intervention, as this almost never solves problems, as evidenced by our interventions in Libya and Afghanistan. We will pull troops out of the middle east, work for peace with North Korea, and work for peace and free trade with nations such as China and the European Union. We think all of America should agree with our peaceful policies, especially young millenials, another group we are targeting; they have the most to lose if we go to war.
