TAS has two primary programs, English as a Second Language (ESL) and High School Equivalency (HSE), including GED preparation in English and Spanish. TAS is growing and is currently accepting applications for credentialed substitute teachers. Classes are held mostly in the evenings and there are some day time hours.

TAS will consider applications from credentialed teachers/substitutes who enjoy working with adults, primarily in Larkspur. Teachers/substitutes must hold a valid California teaching credential. The hourly rate is \$32.50 per hour plus compensation prep time.
