

# Social Issues Community Service

Over the course of the semester all Social Issues students will volunteer 10 hours of their time to serve the community. The practical purpose of this assignment is to engage students in meaningful activities that will demonstrate the benefit of community service. Those students who fail to complete this requirement will receive a reduction of two grade levels on their Social Issues semester grade. For more information consult the Tamalpais Union High School District course of study. Students who volunteer their time at Redwood High School will not be accepted (these are deemed school service hours) you need to be working in the community at large. While working on a community service project all students must be sure to have an adult supervisor sign and complete the information below. This piece of paper must be handed in when you present.

The College and Career Center (room 111) is a great resource to use in discovering what opportunities are available in the community. While you're completing your community service it is necessary for you to take pictures (at least 5) of yourself working/volunteering at that particular place/event. These pictures will then be use for your power point presentation. Every student will present a three slide power point presentation about their community service experience. This presentation can be made at anytime throughout the semester once you have completed your service hours. All community service hours should be completed by **Monday, May 18, 2020**. If you complete and present your 10 hours of community prior to Spring Break you will be given 10 points of extra credit on your Architect of Hope Project. For those that choose two or three different and unique community services opportunities you will not need to make separate power points for each one. Listed below are the directions for each slide layout.

**Slide #1 & #2** - Explain why you chose this particular organization to complete your service. How did you get in contact and book your community service. Describe the organization that you are working for? Tell me where your community service took place. (*pictures of you in action*)

**Slide #3 & #4** - What exactly did your day of community service entailed. Did you work on your own or with a group, friend, family member? Was it easier or more difficult than you expected? (*pictures of you in action*)

**Slide #5** - What about this experience did you find satisfying or meaningful? Would you suggest this organization for community service to Social Issues students next year? Will you continue with this community service in the future? (*pictures of you in action*)
