

RHS Electronics Policy

Electronic Signaling Devices

Pursuant to its authority under the Education Code 48901.5, the Board finds that students may possess electronic signaling devices while the students are on campus, while attending school-sponsored activities, or while under the supervision and control of school district employees.

Students must ensure that the device is turned off and out of sight during instructional periods. All amplification and notification functions of such devices shall remain in the "off" position during instructional periods. No student is prohibited from possessing or using an electronic signaling device that is determined by a licensed physician and surgeon to be essential for the health of a student and use of which is limited for purposes related to the health of the student.

Unlawful use of an electronic signaling device may be grounds for suspension.
